Success by the Numbers

D10 Member KUDOS...

221 District 10 members earned education awards since July 1, 2019.

49 clubs have 100% of their club officers adopted to Pathways —OUTSTANDING!

83 Clubs in District 10 are eligible to earn **point 9** in the Distinguished Club Program (DCP) because they met the minimum requirement of having 4 officers attend training.

22 clubs of those clubs are in the running for the **Magnificent 7** because they had all 7 club officers trained in the first round; *three times more than last year!*

94 clubs are eligible to earn **point 10** of the DCP because they submitted their club officer lists in on-time by June 30, 2019

57 clubs have submitted on-time dues for October 1 in advance

Project Access

You can now review each project at any level of your path!

Does this mean that you can complete projects in any order?

Levels still need to be approved in order. However, you can work on a project that is at a higher level, when appropriate.

For example, a Level 4 project might require you to lead a team. You may have an opportunity to lead a team while on Level 2 of your path. You can complete the leadership portion of the project while you are working in Level 2 but the speech for the project should not be given until you have advanced to Level 4 of that path.

Get Started in Pathways

June 30, 2020 is the last day that members can receive credit for speeches and leadership projects completed from the Traditional Program.

We encourage members, especially officers, to begin using Pathways now, even if you are still working in the Traditional Program.

Pathways Mentor Program

We encourage experienced members to complete the Pathways Mentor Program in order to help new members. The Mentor Program becomes available after a member has completed Level 2 of any path.

Base Camp Managers - Member Progress

Base Camp Manager, in addition to viewing which level your members are working on, you can now view the exact project as well.

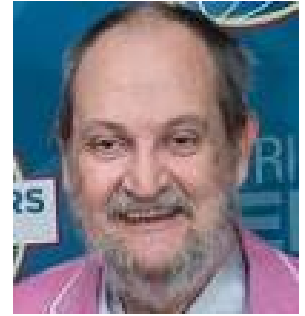
Chartering Clubs
